

RGFPSL Thundercats

The Rocklin Thundercats are a recreational competitive B level softball team offered by RGFPSL. The Thundercats teams play a more competitive schedule, have a greater financial commitment and longer season than a regular recreational or All Star teams. Playing time is earned.

A Thundercats coach is selected by an application and interview process. The team is selected by the coach in a try out format. The team forms by January and will begin practice and games immediately after the team have been selected. The season is considered a yearlong commitment.

We have two types of Thundercats teams, dedicated Select team or a Select/Recreational combination team. The style of season the team will participate in 2018 will be determined by the number of recreational teams in the division and/or talent evaluation of the division.

The dedicated Select Thundercats would not play on a recreational team for the league in the spring. These players just play as Thundercats during the Select season. The Thundercats attend approximately 5 tournaments in the spring and 4 or 5 tournaments in the summer. The goal and the focus of the Thundercats team are to qualify for The Western National Tournament usually scheduled during the first week of August.

The Select/Recreation combination team is selected the same way the dedicated Select Thundercats are selected and will play in about the same number of tournaments and has the same goal of qualifying for the Western National Tournament. The girls on this type of Thundercats team will also be placed on a recreational spring team.

The Thundercats program is for the girl who is looking for a more competitive format. Playing for the Thundercats requires a larger time and financial commitment. Thundercats teams travel to games and tournaments throughout the Sacramento region and may stay out of town to compete in tournaments out of the area. Parents will have fundraising responsibilities. Playing time is earned not guaranteed.

RGFPSL is ready to start accepting applications for coaches for the upcoming 2018 season. You will find the coach application under the information tab in the documents on Team Sideline. Coaches who are interested must complete an application and submit the application to the ASA B Coordinator Andy Smith by October 13th. We will be conducting new coach applicant interviews on the 16th and 20th of October. Try outs for the 2018 season will be held in November. The league is hoping to field a 10U, 12U and 14U team in 2018.
